Dear Clady:

The Georgia Public Service Commission has received a complaint against Superior Transportation, Inc. alleging that you are operating as a for hire charter bus company without being properly licensed. This is a reminder that in order to operate as a charter bus company in Georgia, you must be licensed and approved by the Commission and a Certificate must be granted. If you are presently conducting operations you are doing so illegally, (O.C.G.A. §46-7-85.3), and must **CEASE AND DESIST** from conducting such operations until a certificate has been granted by the Commission. Georgia law provides for a fine to be imposed on those carriers that operate illegally.

Local law enforcement as well as the Department of Public Safety has been advised that authority has not been granted by the Georgia Public Service Commission. Therefore, if seen conducting business, your bus will be stopped and your driver(s) will have to produce valid commercial liability insurance, proper certification and vehicle identification documentation or risk having your vehicle(s) impounded. Notice would then be served for you to appear at a rule nisi hearing (O.C.G.A. §46-7-85.3, O.C.G.A. §40-5-143-145).
